

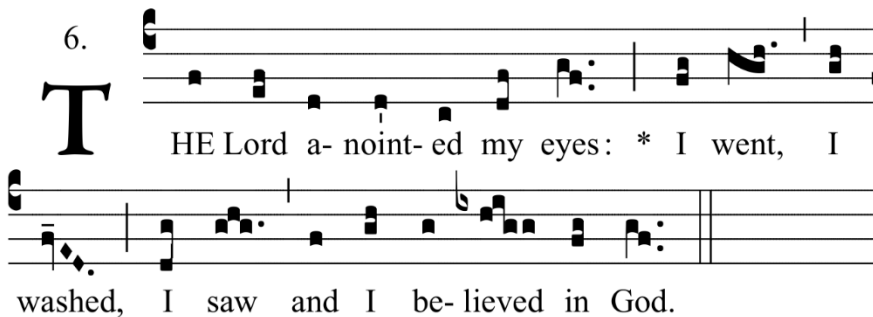
Fourth Sunday of Lent
