




Psalm Tone





- Jerusalem, built <u>as</u> a city with compact unity.
 To it the <u>tribes</u> go up, the tribes of the LORD. *R*/
- 3. According to the de<u>cree</u> for Israel, to give thanks to the name of <u>the LORD</u>. In it are set up <u>judgment seats</u>, seats for the house <u>of David</u>. *R*/
- 4. Pray for the peace of Jerusalem! May those who love you prosper! May peace be within your walls, prosperity in your buildings. *R*/
- 5. Because of my brothers and friends
 I will say, "Peace be within you!"
 Because of the house of the LORD, our God,
 I will pray for your good. R/

2nd Sunday of Advent, Year A



- 1. O God, with your judgment endow the king, and with your justice the king's son; he shall govern your people with justice and your afflicted ones with judgment. *R*/
- 2. Justice shall flower <u>in</u> his days, and profound peace, till the moon be <u>no</u> more. May he rule from <u>sea</u> to sea, and from the River to the ends <u>of</u> the earth. *R*/
- 3. For he shall rescue the poor when <u>he</u> cries out, and the afflicted when he has no one <u>to</u> help him. He shall have pity for the lowly <u>and</u> the poor; the lives of the poor <u>he</u> shall save. *R*/
- 4. May his name be <u>blessed</u> forever; as long as the sun his name shall <u>re</u>main. In him shall all the tribes of the <u>earth</u> be blessed; all the nations shall pro<u>claim</u> his happiness. R/

4th Sunday of Advent, Year A




Psalm Tone Mode 7

 or who may stand in his <u>holy</u> place?
 One whose hands are sinless, whose <u>heart</u> is clean, who desires not what is vain. *R*/
- 3. He shall receive a blessing from the LORD, a reward from God his savior.

 Such is the race that seeks for him, that seeks the face of the God of Jacob. *R*/

 With trumpets and the sound of the horn sing joyfully before the King, the LORD. R/






Psalm Tone

 The LORD bless you <u>from</u> Zion: may you see the prosperity <u>of</u> Jerusalem all the days of <u>your</u> life. R/


Mary, the Mother of God (January 1)



Psalm Tone Mode 6


- May God have pity on <u>us</u> and bless us; may he let his face <u>shine</u> upon us.
