



## Psalm Tone




1. I rejoiced because they said to me,

seats for the house of David. *R/*
4. Pray for the peace of Jerusalem!

Because of the house of the LORD, our God,  
I will pray for your good. *R/*

## Psalm Tone




1. O God, with your judgment endow the king,

all the nations shall proclaim his happiness. *R/*


# Psalm 98




1. Sing to the LORD a new song,

## Psalm Tone




1. The LORD's are the earth and its fullness;

that seeks the face of the God of Jacob. *R/*




Mode 8




1. Blessed is everyone who fears the LORD,

all the days of your life. *R/*


# Psalm 67




1. May God have pity on us and bless us;




1. O God, with your judgment endow the king,
