- All who see me scoff at me; they mock me with parted lips, they wag their heads: [omit C, D]
 "He relied on the LORD; let him deliver him, let him rescue him, if he loves him." R/
- Indeed, many <u>dogs</u> surround me, a pack of evildoers closes in up<u>on</u> me; [omit C, D] they have pierced my hands <u>and</u> my feet; I can count <u>all</u> my bones. R/
- 3. They divide my gar<u>ments</u> among them, and for my vesture they <u>cast</u> lots. *[omit C, D]*But you, O LORD, be not <u>far</u> from me; O my help, has<u>ten</u> to aid me. *R*/
- 4. I will proclaim your name to my brethren; in the midst of the assembly I will praise you: "You who fear the LORD, praise him; all you descendants of Jacob, give glory to him; [omit E] revere him, all you descendants of Israel!" R/
