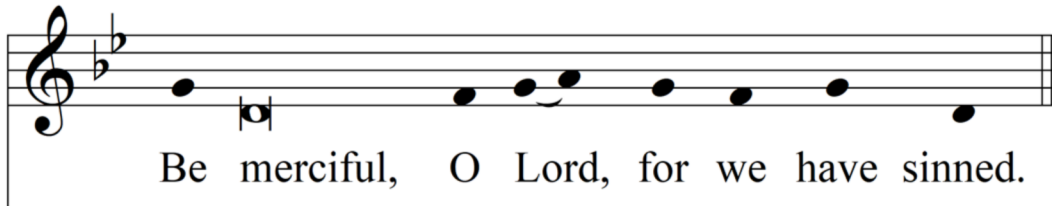

Psalm Tone

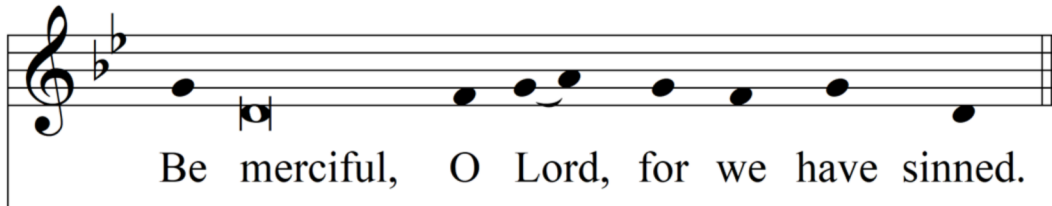


1. Have mercy on me, O God, in your goodness;

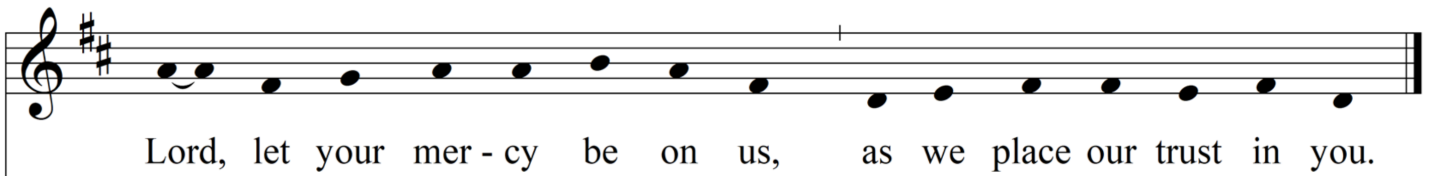

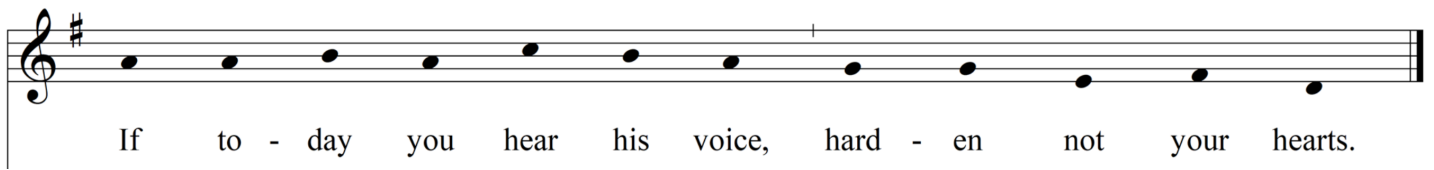


2. Upright is the word of the LORD,

Psalm Tone

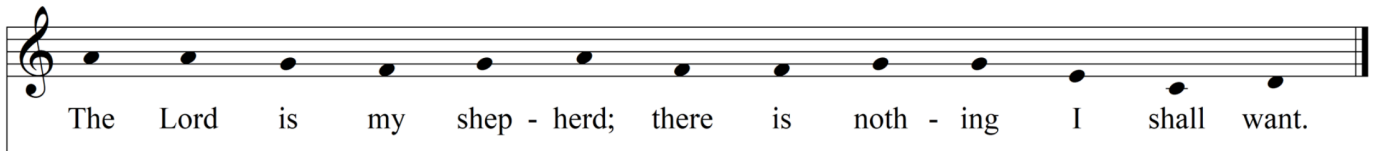


1. Come, let us sing joyfully to the LORD;

they tested me though they had seen my works.” *R/*

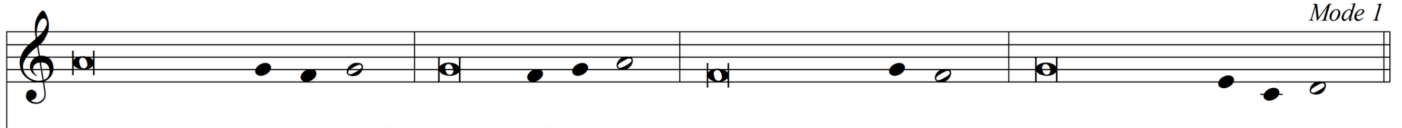

Psalm Tone

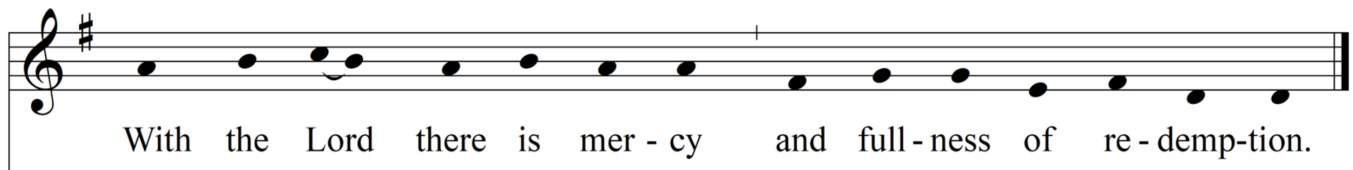


1. The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

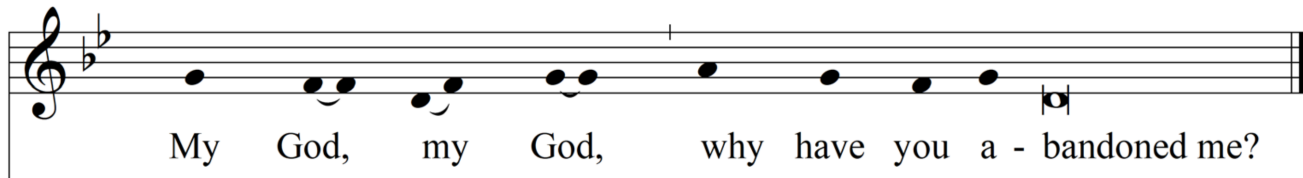


1. Out of the depths I cry to you, O LORD;

Psalm Tone



1. All who see me scoff at me;
they mock me with parted lips, they wag their heads:
[omit C, D]
“He relied on the LORD; let him deliver him,
let him rescue him, if he loves him.” *R/*
2. Indeed, many dogs surround me,
a pack of evildoers closes in upon me;
[omit C, D]
they have pierced my hands and my feet;
I can count all my bones. *R/*
3. They divide my garments among them,
and for my vesture they cast lots.
[omit C, D]
But you, O LORD, be not far from me;
O my help, hasten to aid me. *R/*
4. I will proclaim your name to my brethren;
in the midst of the assembly I will praise you:
“You who fear the LORD, praise him;
all you descendants of Jacob, give glory to him;
[omit E]
revere him, all you descendants of Israel!” *R/*
