





Psalm 85


- 2 O LORD, you have **fav**ored your land, and brought back the cap**tives** of Jacob.

18 He sends forth his word and it **melts** them; at the blowing of his breath the **wat**ers flow.


19 He reveals his word to **Ja**cob; to Israel, his dec**rees** and judgments.





no one unclean may **pass** over it, but it will be **for** his people.


10 And the ransomed of the **Lord** shall return, and enter **Zi**on singing.

They meet with **joy** and gladness, sorrow and **mour**ning flee away.


