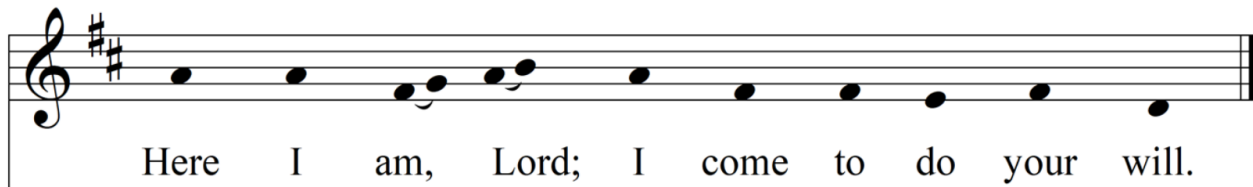


# Psalm 40

## Psalm Tone

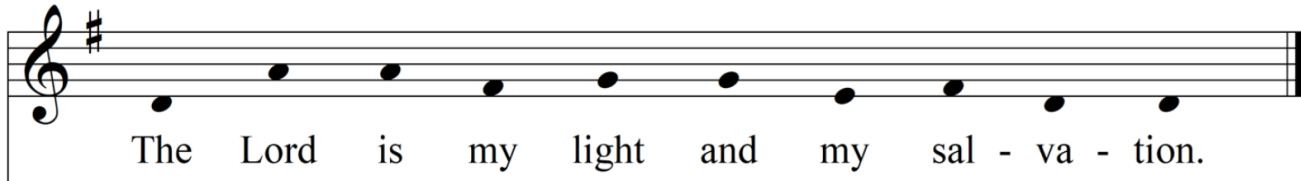


1. I have waited, waited for the LORD,  
and he stooped toward me and heard my cry.  
And he put a new song into my mouth,  
a hymn to our God. *R/*
2. Sacrifice or offering you wished not,  
but ears open to obedience you gave me.  
Holocausts or sin-offerings you sought not;  
then said I, “Behold I come.” *R/*
3. “In the written scroll it is prescribed for me,  
to do your will, O my God, is my delight,  
*[omit C]*  
and your law is within my heart!” *R/*
4. I announced your justice in the vast assembly;  
*[omit B, C]*  
I did not restrain my lips, as you, O LORD, know. *R/*

## Psalm Tone

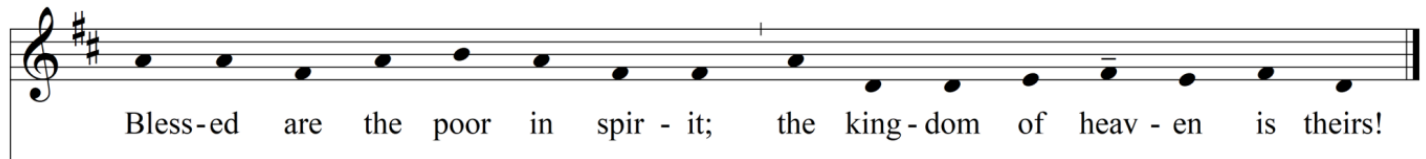


1. The LORD is my light and my salvation;

of whom should I be afraid? *R/*
2. One thing I ask of the LORD; this I seek:  
to dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life,  
that I may gaze on the loveliness of the LORD  
and contemplate his temple. *R/*
5. I believe that I shall see the bounty of the LORD  
in the land of the living.  
Wait for the LORD, with courage;  
be stouthearted, and wait for the LORD. *R/*

Psalm Tone

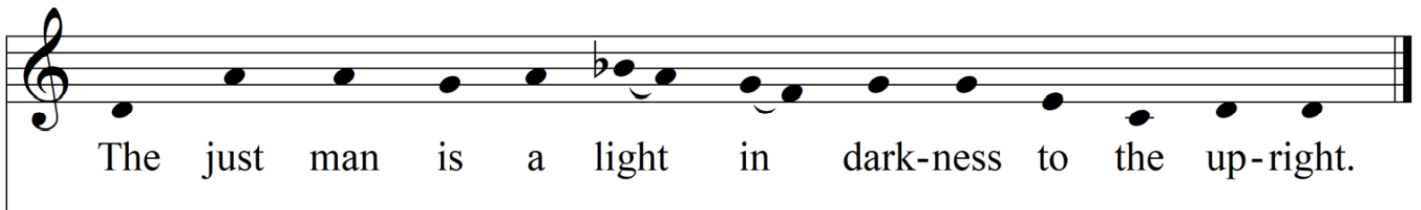


1. The LORD keeps faith forever,

but the way of the wicked he thwarts.  
The LORD shall reign forever;

Psalm Tone



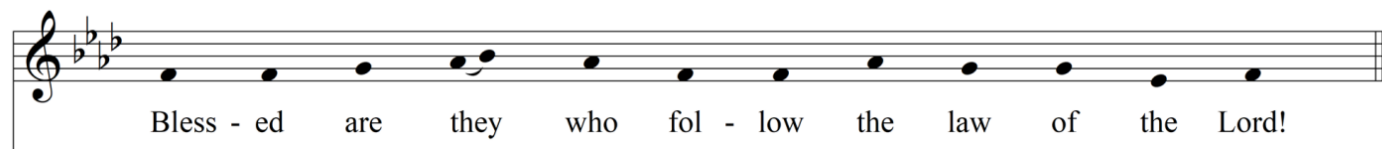
1. Light shines through the darkness for the upright;

of keeping your statutes! *R/*
3. Be good to your servant, that I may live  
and keep your words.  
Open my eyes, that I may consider  
the wonders of your law. *R/*
4. Instruct me, O LORD, in the way of your statutes,  
that I may exactly observe them.  
Give me discernment, that I may observe your law  
and keep it with all my heart. *R/*
