


Psalm 1

3 Whoever does not **slan**der with his tongue, who does no wrong to a neighbor, who casts no **slur** on a friend,


4 who looks with **scorn** on the wicked, but honors those **who** fear the LORD.



15 When he calls on me, I will **an**swer him; I will be with him in distress; I will deliver him, and **give** him glory.


16 With length of days I will content him; I will show him my saving power.

Psalm 29


- 1 Ascribe to the LORD, you heavenly **pow**ers, ascribe to the LORD glo**ry** and strength.



9 My soul **clings** fast to you; your right **hand** upholds me.



Psalm 34


- 2 I will bless the **LORD** at all times; praise of him is always in my mouth.


